1. In the reference cited, an application was submitted to the Board seeking Consent for Establishment (CFE) to set up a Bio Degradable And Compostable manufacturing unit with production capacities as mentioned below, with a proposed project cost of Rs. 2.96 Crores.

2. As per the application, the above activity is to be located at **Sy. No. 173 PLOT NO 18 AND 19, Mulkalapalle (V), Gadwal (M), Gadwal District**.
3. The above site was inspected by the AEE-II, TG. Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Hyderabad, on 20.08.2026 and found that the industry is surrounded by East: Agricultural land; West: Internal Road; North: Open area; South: Agricultural land.
4. The Board, after careful scrutiny of the application, verification report of Regional Officer, Hyderabad hereby issues CONSENT FOR ESTABLISHMENT to the industry, under Section 25 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 21 of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the rules made there under. This Order is issued to manufacture the products mentioned at para (I) only.

5. This Consent Order now issued is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 'A' and Schedule 'B'.
6. This order is issued from pollution control point of view only. Zoning and other regulations are not considered.

### **SCHEDULE – A**

1. The applicant shall make applications through online for renewal of Consent (under Water & Air Acts) and Authorization under HWM Rules at least 120 days before the date of expiry of this order, along with prescribed fee under Water and Air Acts for obtaining Consent & HW Authorization of the Board. The applicant can also apply for Auto Renewal of the CFO atleast 30 days before the expiry of this order as per the procedure and eligibility stipulated in the Board Circular dt.19.11.2015 & 08.12.2015 (available in Board's Website: <http://tspcb.cgg.gov.in/Pages/Circulars.aspx>).
2. Concealing the factual data or submission of false information/ fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned in this order may result in withdrawal of this order and attract action under the provisions of relevant pollution control Acts.
3. The industry may explore the possibility of tapping the solar energy for their energy requirements.
4. Any person aggrieved by an order made by the State Board under Section 25, Section 26, Section 27 of Water Act, 1974 or Section 21 of Air Act, 1981 may within thirty days from the date on which the order is communicated to him, prefer an appeal as per the State Water Rules, 1976 and Air Rules, 1982, to such authority (hereinafter referred to as the Appellate Authority) constituted under Section 28 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 31 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
5. The Board reserves its right to modify above conditions or stipulate any further conditions and to take action including revoke of this order in the interest of protection of public health and environment

### **SCHEDULE – B**

1. **The industry shall pay additional consent fee of Rs. 5,550/- for already started construction without obtaining CFE of the Board.**
2. This order is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue
3. The industry shall obtain NOC from CGWA within One month, if any drawl of ground water required and submit to this office.
4. The source of water is Ground Water and the maximum permitted water consumption shall not exceed the following quantities.

5. The maximum waste water generation (KLD) shall not exceed the following:

6. The industry should comply with the National ambient air quality standards as per MoEF, GoI notification dated. 18.11.2009 along the premises of the factory as prescribed below.

7. The industry shall not discharge any waste water outside the factory premises.
8. The industry shall not cause any air pollution / dust nuisance to the surrounding environment.
9. The industry shall not dispose solid waste outside the factory premises under any circumstances.
10. The industry shall follow Plastic Waste (Management & Handling) Rules, 2016 and their amendment issued thereof.
11. The industry shall not cause any air pollution / dust nuisance to the surrounding environment.
12. The industry shall develop 33% of the total area as thick green belt all along the boundary of the unit and also in the vacant places with all tall growing trees with wide leaf area.
13. The industry shall comply with all the Rules and Regulations specified in Water (P&C of P) Act, 1974, Air (P&C of P) Act, 1981 and Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and their amendments issued thereof.
14. The industry shall not manufacture any extra products or extra capacities without obtaining CFE/CFO of the Board.
15. The industry shall not take up trial production for proposed activity without obtaining Consent for Operation of the Board.
16. The industry shall comply with Rules & Regulations notified by Ministry of Law and Justice, Govt. of India, regarding the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991.
17. The industry shall comply with all the directions issued by the Board from time to time.
18. The industry shall apply & obtain CPCB, Extended Producer's Responsibility (EPR) registration as per Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.
19. The industry shall follow all the provisions of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016. Any violation of provisions of these Rules and amendments thereof will attract the penal provision of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

20. The Board reserves its right to modify above conditions or stipulate any further conditions and to take action including revoke of this order in the interest of environment protection.
21. This Order is issued to the industry without prejudice to the action taken by the Task Force of the Board.
